**WEIGHT DIVISIONS:**

Boys: 5-6, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16  
Girls: 5-6, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16  
All Youth Divisions will be divided into light, medium & heavy.  
Additional brackets may be added.  
Senior Men Novice: White & San-kyu belts compete together.  
Senior Men Elite: Ik-kyu & Ni-kyu ranks compete with Black Belts  
Master's Division: All ranks inclusive age 35 and up.  
(35 & up) and Kata Competition if there is an interest.  
Senior Women Novice: White & San-kyu belts compete together.  
Senior Women Elite: Ik-kyu & Ni-kyu ranks compete with Black Belts  
**NOTE: NO ARM BARS ALLOWED IN SENIOR MEN OR WOMEN NOVICE DIVISIONS**  
(35 & up) and Kata Competition if there is an interest.

\*\* The Tournament Director reserves the right to add, delete or modify any Division to ensure the safety of the competitors.

- NOTE:** Approximately 10 percent maximum weight differential for Juniors and approximately 15 pounds for Seniors. Juniors will only be moved one age bracket due to weight.. Juniors who cannot be safely fit within a weight class, will receive a refund. Refunds will be issued for uncontested matches.
- RULES:** IJF Rules and the IJF Sporting Code will be in effect. Rules may be modified for the safety of the contestants.
- RULES:** Current IJF Rules modified:  
No Kani-basmi allowed – all divisions.  
Shime-waza allowed in Junior Divisions for 13 years old & up.  
Kansetsu allowed in Senior Divisions regardless of contestant's age.
- ELIMINATION SYSTEM:** Double Elimination or modified pool system.
- MATCH TIMES:** Juniors – 3 minutes, Senior Men & Women – 4 minutes, Masters – 4 minutes.  
Golden Score will be used to determine winner.
- AWARDS:** Medals for first, second and third place winners.  
Outstanding Junior and Senior Judoka Awards  
Outstanding Team Award.
- LOCATION:** Geraldine B. Myers Recreation Center
- MAT SURFACE:** 42 X 42 International certified areas.  
Scoring by electronic scoreboards.

#### **ATTENTION COACHES AND CONTESTANTS**

- **Contestants limited to their division/weight class and one additional division.**
- **A Blue Judo gi must be worn in its entirety. No mixing of blue and white gi.**
- **Pooling or elimination systems are subject to change on the day of the tournament depending on the number of contestants registering for the competition.**
- **Every effort will be made during first round to match beginners (white, yellow and orange).**
- **Contestants are responsible for providing their own blue and white belt. No sashes will be issued. No blue Judogi will be worn on the white side.**
